# Enterprise and colocation operators face rising costs in 2025

#### **SUMMARY**

Most data center operators plan to spend more in 2025 than the previous year. However, spending strategies vary widely between enterprises and colocation providers, and each faces its own risks from supply chain issues.


Results from the Uptime Institute Data Center and IT Spending Survey 2024 show how operators across different market segments plan to navigate cost challenges in 2025.


#### Enterprises to prioritize IT spending in 2025

Which of the following will experience the single greatest spending increase in 2025?




#### Operators plan to spend more on power and cooling

#### Power and IT hardware drive enterprise costs


In which areas has your organization experienced the greatest unit cost increases over the past 12 months? Choose no more than two.






#### Manufacturing issues drive most capital project delays

Have any of your organization's capital projects been delayed over the past 12 months?




#### More operators expect higher budgets in 2025

Do you expect your company's budget (for facilities, power, IT hardware, etc.) to increase, decrease or remain the same in 2025 versus 2024?




#### More colocations report improved supply chains

Which of the following best describes your organization's overall data center supply chain experience over the past six months?




#### Supply chain issues disrupt capacity and expansion plans

Which of the following has had the most significant impact on your organization as a result of supply chain disruptions?




#### Colocations face greater PDU and genset supply challenges


